Take time to explore the beautiful grounds before departing to visit the Albert Gilles Copper Museum to learn about the art of Copper as well as enjoy a demonstration on the detailed work involved in each creation. Duration: approximately 6 hour(s).

◆ Flavors and Aromas of Old Montreal w/ Lunch - MONTREAL

Begin with lunch at a popular restaurant, located in the heart of the Old Section of Montreal.
