Dr. Bryan Schurle

Dr. Bryan Schurle is a professor of Agricultural Economics at Kansas State University. He is also an award-winning educator with teaching experience that includes agricultural economics and finance, spreadsheet applications, optimization methods and risk management. His presentation will center on ag real estate prices – a timely topic given the current economy.
